PART 3: SECURITY AND PROCEDURES

New:

Cadets arriving late are to report to Room 106 or the Duty Officer and must at some time during the parade evening report to their flight commanders that they have arrived.

Instructors are to provide lesson plans to the Trg O no later than the week prior to the class they are to instruct.

All cadets have an assigned duty location. They must be at their assigned location unless authorized. Cadets are not allowed to wander around the building.

Cadets are reminded that they are to phone or email if they cannot attend a mandatory event (e.g. Wed evening parade). They should preferably contact their Flight Section but may also contact the AdmO. Flight Sections are to remind cadets of this requirement.
