Evaluation Criteria Provincial Post-secondary Study Bursary – Air Cadet League of Canada Quebec and Ottawa Valley Provincial Committee

The result is based out of 100 points, which are divided as follows:

Cadet File (10 %)

- This will take into account cadet participation during his/her time at the squadron:
 - Summer Camps or virtual attended: 1 point each (maximum of 5 points)
 - Current rank: Cpl/FCpl 1 point; Sgt 2 points; FSgt 3 points; WO2 4 points; and WO1 5 points

School Record (40 %)

General Average: Based on the academic results, as found in the June report card of the preceding school year 70 to 74% – 15 points; 75 to 79% – 20 points; 80 to 84% – 25 points; 85 to 89% – 30 points; 90 to 94% – 35 points; and 95 to 100% – 40 points.

Letter from current School Administrator (5 %)

 It is important that the candidate attach a letter from a school administrator attesting to the fact that he/she is a full-time student at a recognized educational institution. The full 5 points are awarded if this attestation is submitted within the established deadline.

Letter of recommendation from the Chairperson and Commanding Officer (5 %)

• A letter from the Chairperson and the Commanding Officer that explains why they chose this candidate. The full 5 points are awarded if this attestation is submitted within the established deadline.

Personal Narrative - according to CPQVO-203EV evaluation (10%)

• Candidates must submit a personal narrative justifying their reasons for applying for the bursary.

Interview - according to CPQVO-203EV evaluation (30 %)

• Candidates will be interviewed by a selection committee established by the Regional Coordinator. This interview will take into consideration the candidate's motivation for further studies, continuity within the cadet program and personal determination.

It should be noted that priority for the study bursary will be given to cadets returning to the squadron in September as a cadet, CIC Officer or Civilian Instructor.
